
The capital, Edinburgh, hosts some of the most famous festivals in the world, such as the Fringe Festival, which takes place in August.

Day trip to historic Stirling with visits to Stirling Castle, the William Wallace Memorial, and time to explore the city.

Afternoon concert at the Holy Rude Church as part of your summer concert tour.

Farewell meal at a local restaurant. Accommodation in Stirling or Glasgow.

### DAY 6

Optional morning excursion to Linlithgow, the birthplace of Mary Queen of Scots, or participation in a "Learn to Play the Bagpipes" workshop at the National Piping Centre in Glasgow.

In the afternoon, transfer to the departure airport.
