CAMINO DE SANTIAGO

Andalucía is a region rich in culture, history, festivities, nature, and outstanding gastronomy. You can visit awe-inspiring monuments, explore a natural environment full of contrasts, experience unique local celebrations, and savor delicious products.

To immerse yourself in Andalusian culture, you can explore its UNESCO World Heritage sites, such as the Alhambra, Generalife, and Albaicín in Granada, the historic center with the Mosque in Córdoba, the Cathedral, Alcázar, and Archivo de Indias in Seville, and the monumental towns of Úbeda and Baeza in Jaén. You will also enjoy vibrant festivals like Semana Santa, the Carnival of Cádiz, the Rocío in Huelva, and the Feria de Abril in Seville.



The natural landscapes in Andalucía are diverse, ranging from the beaches of the Costa del Sol, Costa de la Luz, and Almería to the vast olive groves in Jaén. Explore the Doñana National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site, or even ski in the Sierra Nevada resort during winter.

Lastly, Andalucía offers an unparalleled gastronomic experience, with wines from Jerez (Cádiz) and Montilla-Moriles (Córdoba), fried fish from Cádiz and Málaga, hams from Huelva and Córdoba, olive oil, and iconic dishes such as gazpacho and salmorejo.





ITINERARY







DAY 1

Arrival at Bilbao airport. Reception at the airport. Visit to the Guggenheim Museum. Departure to Burgos. Check-in and dinner.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel. Rehearsal in the morning. Walk on the Camino de Santiago. Singing in a church on the Camino. Visit to the village of Castrojeriz. Departure to Burgos. Tapas dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 3


Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Santibáñez. Walk on the Camino de Santiago. Arrival at the Crucero de Santo Toribio. Singing upon arrival. Departure to Astorga. Dinner and free time.

DAY 4

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Santa Catalina de Somoza for a short walk. Arrival at Rabanal del Camino and singing outside the church. Departure to Lugo. Concert at Lugo Cathedral. Dinner and free time.







DAY 5

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Santiago de Compostela. Morning Mass for pilgrims. Rest of the day free.

DAY 6

Breakfast at the hotel. Rehearsal in the morning. Concert at Santiago de Compostela Cathedral. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 7

Breakfast at the hotel and departure. Transfer to the airport.




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
