ANDALUSIA

Andalucía is a region rich in culture, history, festivities, nature, and outstanding gastronomy. You can visit awe-inspiring monuments, explore a natural environment full of contrasts, experience unique local celebrations, and savor delicious products.

To immerse yourself in Andalusian culture, you can explore its UNESCO World Heritage sites, such as the Alhambra, Generalife, and Albaicín in Granada, the historic center with the Mosque in Córdoba, the Cathedral, Alcázar, and Archivo de Indias in Seville, and the monumental towns of Úbeda and Baeza in Jaén. You will also enjoy vibrant festivals like Semana Santa, the Carnival of Cádiz, the Rocío in Huelva, and the Feria de Abril in Seville.



The natural landscapes in Andalucía are diverse, ranging from the beaches of the Costa del Sol, Costa de la Luz, and Almería to the vast olive groves in Jaén. Explore the Doñana National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site, or even ski in the Sierra Nevada resort during winter.

Lastly, Andalucía offers an unparalleled gastronomic experience, with wines from Jerez (Cádiz) and Montilla-Moriles (Córdoba), fried fish from Cádiz and Málaga, hams from Huelva and Córdoba, olive oil, and iconic dishes such as gazpacho and salmorejo.





ITINERARY







DAY 1: Madrid - Córdoba

Arrival at Madrid Airport.

Transfer to Atocha AVE Station to board the high-speed train to Córdoba. Tour of the city to visit the famous Mezquita/Cathedral and the Jewish Quarter. Transfer to the hotel. Check-in and welcome dinner at a typical restaurant. Overnight at the hotel in Córdoba.

DAY 2: Seville

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for Seville. City tour to visit María Luisa Park, Plaza de España, the typical Santa Cruz neighborhood, and the "Real Alcázar" or "Royal Fortress". Lunch at your leisure. In the afternoon, concert at one of Seville's main venues.

Dinner at your leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Seville.

DAY 3: Seville - Granada

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for Granada. City tour to visit the stunning Alhambra with its beautiful Nasrid Palaces and the Generalife. Lunch and dinner at your leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Granada.

DAY 4: Granada

Breakfast at the hotel.

Guided tour of the old town to visit the historic center and the Royal Chapel, the Gothic mausoleum and burial place of Ferdinand and Isabella. Lunch at your leisure.

In the afternoon, concert at the main church of Granada. Dinner at your leisure. Experience a performance in the Sacromonte, the perfect acoustic venue for the sounds of flamenco guitar and the strong rhythms of flamenco dance. Overnight at the hotel in Granada.







DAY 5: Granada - Málaga

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for Málaga. Visit the city to see the Gibralfaro. Free time for shopping in the center of Málaga. Lunch and dinner at your leisure. Overnight at the hotel in Málaga.

DAY 6: Marbella - Málaga

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for Marbella. Free time in Marbella, one of the main destinations on the Costa del Sol. Lunch at your leisure. Meeting with the local choir and concert, featuring alternative presentations and

a final joint performance.

Dinner at your leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Málaga.

DAY 7: Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for the María Zambrano train station to take the high-speed train to Madrid. Free time in Madrid. Lunch at your leisure. Departure for Madrid airport.

By bus. If you have time, this option allows you to enjoy some scenic routes. We can quote the price for bus transport upon request.




