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SAN MARINO

The **19th International Choirfestival "Cantate Adriatica"** will be held again in the Republic of San Marino **from 30th may to 2nd june 2024**.

The Republic of San Marino, is pleased to invite your choir to the festival and to offer you a charming setting. With an area of only 61 km², San Marino, is situated between the Italian regions of Romagna and Marche, only a few kilometers from the Adriatic sea coast.

The Republic of San Marino is not only one of the smallest states in the world, but it is also **the oldest state**. On July 7, 2008 the Republic of San Marino, thanks to the unique character of its history and institutional heritage, was given an outstanding recognition by **UNESCO's** Committee: the inscription in the prestigious List of World Heritage Sites.

Except for its numerous historical monuments, museums and history, San Marino offers participation in the choral festival "**Cantate Adriatica**". During the friendship concerts you will have an opportunity to get to know San Marino's surroundings and the beauty of the Adriatic Sea Coast. Friendship concerts will take place in theatres, concert halls and churches of picturesque towns.

San Marino and neighboring regions present their best side in spring with pleasant summer temperatures and a lack of tourists. The Mediterranean climate, Italian lifestyle and excellent cuisine will allow you to forget all your troubles and will guarantee several calm and relaxing days.

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ITINERARY



DAY 1

Arrival in late afternoon to the hotel in San Marino, at the coast from Rimini or Riccione.

Check-in and dinner at the Hotel. Free time after dinner.

DAY 2

Breakfast in hotel. Depart for **San Marino**, the oldest republic in the world. In the morning a walking tour of the streets and the walls of the medieval town (approximately 1 hour without entrance fees). Unforgettable is the visit of the 3 towers, as represented in the flag's emblem, with their beautiful view. After this, tour departure for the official opening of the festival with a welcoming glass of wine and refreshments. Afternoon is free for individual activities. In the late afternoon rehearsal in the hotel.

Dinner at hotel and departure for the **friendship concert**.

DAY 3

Breakfast in hotel. Morning is free at disposal or take part in some optional excursion, f.e. to Gradara, San Leo or a panorama boat trip along the coast. Lunch on your own.

Afternoon preparation for the concert and rehearsal in the hotel.

Departure for the **final concert** in a Theatre of San Marino.

After the concert, transfer to the restaurant for the farewell dinner together with all other participating choirs.

DAY 4

Breakfast in hotel and return home or transfer to the church for a musical accompaniment of the church service. After the service, departure for home.

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Extra Services

Guided Tour of Urbino & Gradara

Urbino is a splendid city that still maintains a typical Renaissance atmosphere intact. The historic center, with its characteristic medieval districts made up of narrow red-brick alleyways and large Renaissance squares with imposing buildings: the Duomo, Piazza del Rinascimento, the Church of San Domenico, the Piazza della Repubblica, the Palazzo Ducale. Gradara, a small medieval village with the Rocca Malatestiana, an imposing fortification build in the 13th century by the Rimini family of Malatesta and theater of Malatesta history and of the famous love story of Paolo and Francesca.



Guided Tour of San Leo

San Leo is in the heart of the Montefeltro countryside to the south-west of Rimini on a hilltop 600 metres above sea level that has been occupied since Roman times. San Leo is listed as one of the 'most beautiful villages in Italy' and has also been awarded the Orange Flag award for sustainable tourism. The highlight of San Leo is the stunningly located castle, on a large craggy rock above the village (or rather a precipitous cliff, on one side) and very well worth the short steep climb from the village. It even impressed Dante, who based his descriptions of purgatory on the site.



Lunch in San Marino, Urbino, Gradara with 3 course menu and drinks. **Panorama cruise** the adriatic coast with drinks on board (ca. 2 hours).

Wine tasting of 3 different wines with small snacks.

Pesaro Guided Tour the birth house and national museum of G. Rossini.



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
