ITINERARY



DAY 1

Arrival in the afternoon at the hotel on the Rimini / Riccione coast. Check-in and dinner at the hotel. Free time after dinner.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

The morning is free for leisure or to participate in an optional excursion. For example, an excursion to **Gradara** or a **scenic boat ride** along the coast.

Lunch on your own. Free time at the beach in the afternoon. Dinner at the hotel. After dinner, transfer to your **outdoor concert** in a square or pedestrian area.

After the concert, return to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 3

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to **San Marino**, the oldest republic in the world. In the morning, a walking tour through the streets and walls of the medieval city (approximately 1 hour without entrance fees).

The visit to the three towers, depicted in the emblem of the flag, is unforgettable, along with its beautiful views.

Lunch in San Marino. In the afternoon, **parade** through the historic center of San Marino with a **Grand Finale in Piazza Sant'Agata**. Then, transfer to the restaurant. **Aperitif with local specialties** alongside all participating bands and orchestras in a winery. After the Farewell Party, transfer back to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 4

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Departure and journey back.









The Republic of San Marino

The Republic of San Marino, with an area of only 61 km², is situated between the Italian regions of Romagna and Marche, just a few kilometers from the Adriatic Sea coast.

According to legend, San Marino was founded in the year 301 AD by the Dalmatian stonecutter Marino. He came here to hide from the Roman Emperor Diocletian during the period of Christian persecution. Since then, this small state has taken pride in its freedom and has been able to consistently defend its independence in the past.


